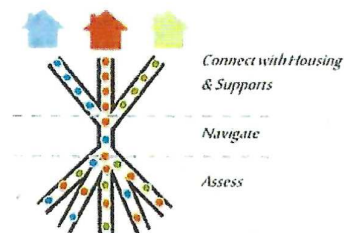
For Veterans who are homeless or at-risk of becoming homeless:
